

Attend the Planning and Zoning Meeting

Why your presence matters

Planning and Zoning (P&Z;) recommendations shape what ultimately goes to City Council. A full room sends a clear, undeniable signal that the community is engaged, informed, and paying attention. We have spent years getting to this point. Showing up matters.

Meeting Details

Location: City Hall, Second Floor

Security: You will pass through a security screening. Police officers will scan attendees and inspect purses or briefcases.

Arrival Time: Please arrive at least 30 minutes early. We expect screening to take time, and we want the room full before the meeting begins.

How to Participate

You have two ways to participate:

Option A — Attend in Person (Strongly Encouraged)

Arrive early and enter together if possible. Take a seat and remain present throughout the item. You do not need to speak for your presence to count.

A full room is a vote of confidence in the community — and a reminder that these decisions have real, permanent consequences.

Option B — Provide Public Comment

Speakers are typically called in the order they sign up. Keep remarks concise and focused on the decision before the board. Be respectful, factual, and calm.

The recommendation made here carries weight when the matter proceeds to City Council.
